Paint

Unused/Unopened Paint:

- Habitat for Humanity Restore

To discard:

- Add equal parts cat litter to paint in the can. Stir until it thickens. Allow the mixture to sit for one hour. Dispose of dried paint in regular garbage.
- Pour unused paint onto cardboard. Allow paint on cardboard to dry. Dispose of dried paint and can in regular garbage.
- If you prefer to recycle the container, dispose at your local City/County Household Hazardous Waste Day.
- For unwanted, unused paint, dispose at your local City/County Household Hazardous Waste Day.

The Alabama Department of Environmental Management recommends using a triple rise procedure: Fill the container $\frac{1}{4}$ full of water or oil. Swirl for 30 seconds and pour the rinse solution into a sprayer. Repeat two times. Spray the rinse water over a target plant or area. Wrap the container in newspaper and dispose the container in your regular garbage.

If you prefer to recycle the container, contact the Alabama Department of Agriculture and Industries for Information on the Pesticide Container Recycling Program. 334-240-7100

For unwanted, unused cleaners, pesticides, herbicides, or fertilizers, dispose at your local city/county Household Hazardous Waste Day.
